

How to edit a blog post on WordPress:

1. From the dashboard, click Posts
2. Find the post you would like to edit from the list of posts you have created, and click the edit option
3. Once open, edit the blog in the visual screen (the text screen will give you lots of code, but this is where you could, for example, copy and paste a YouTube video)
4. Click the blue update button on the right hand side (the arrow below points in its direction)
5. Then click “View Post” to preview how your changes have turned out
